COVID-19 Update for Chiropractors

After additional communications with the governor's office, the Board is pleased to release this updated guidance concerning the provision of wellness care by our licensees to the public.

Licensees will be permitted to provide wellness care to patients as of **May 1, 2020**, with the understanding that they should continue to adhere to safety and prevention best practices specified in the most current advice from the Centers for Disease Control.

The Board acknowledges that essential health care in the context of chiropractic services often includes wellness care, and many patients embrace and demand those services as an essential component of their health care regimen. The Board reminds licensees that they remain responsible for Board rules concerning safe and sanitary conditions, scope of practice, and documentation of professional services.

The Board appreciates everyone's cooperation and outstanding professional behavior during this incredibly stressful and economically challenging situation.
